Sunshine or Storm Clouds on the Horizon in Practical Legal Training?

CALL FOR PAPERS STILL OPEN

Practical Legal Training (PLT) is facing policy changes in a number of jurisdictions that in some cases extend to whether PLT will continue as a mandatory requirement for admissions purposes there. This provides an opportunity for presenters to discuss the pedagogical approaches which they use in PLT and how these add value to the experiential learning needs of their students. Of similar interest will be continued changes to the nature of legal practice and how PLT can address these changes. Also, as practice and the study of law become ever more demanding, presenters can share their perspectives on the relatively modern field of resilience training.

The topic is designed to address any theme related to changes in regulation, presenters' insights and experiences in teaching and developing curriculums in PLT and current strategies to deal with stress in practice and legal education. However, other topics advancing the understanding and progress of PLT are also welcome.

Key Note Speaker



Anthony Rogers
GBS, QC, JP, FCIS

Mr Rogers was called to the English Bar in 1969 and appointed Queen's Counsel in 1984 prior to joining Hong Kong's judiciary in 1993 and eventually elevating to Vice-President of the Court of Appeal in 2000 until his retirement a decade later in 2011.

Amongst his other high profile appointments, Mr Rogers was former Chairman of the Standing Committee on Company Law and also a previous member of the Basic Law Consultative Committee.

Mr Rogers is company secretary of the Hong Kong Rowing Association and a number of other sports associations and the Chairman of the Disciplinary Committee of the Hong Kong Doping Committee. He is also currently the Chairman of the Clearing and System Settlements Appeals Tribunal, Hong Kong. Mr Rogers is also a CEDR Accredited Mediator and a Member of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and on panels at the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitration. He acts as a mediator and arbitrator continuing his contribution to dispute resolution in society as well as being called upon to be an expert witness on Hong Kong law from time to time.

In October 2016, Mr Rogers was appointed as the replacement Chairman of the Consultants undertaking the Standing Committee on Legal Education and Training's broad ranging and landmark Comprehensive Review of Legal Education and Training in Hong Kong. The Consultants, as part of their overall review, examined the operation of the Postgraduate Certificate in Laws ("PCLL") which provides mandatory, pre-admission, practical legal training in a simulated learning environment in Hong Kong, as well as potential alternatives to that model. The Final Report of the Consultants on the Comprehensive Review of Legal Education and Training was published in April 2018.
